



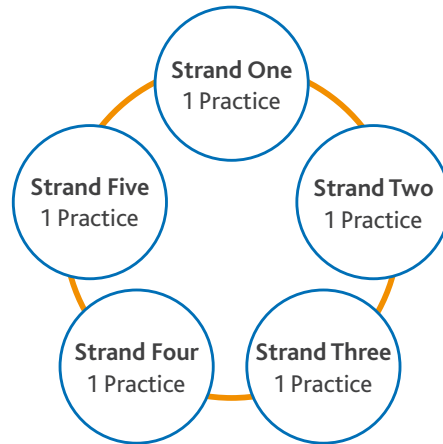
About the Volunteer Friendly Offer

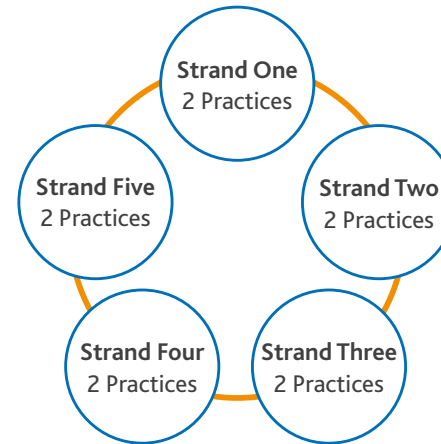

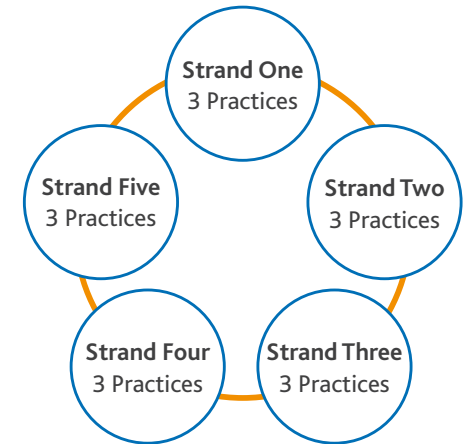
